What Is the Maternal Guidance Program?

The Ambetter Maternal Guidance Program aims to provide you with support throughout your entire pregnancy and post-partum period. This program will provide an open line of communication between you and your assigned Ambetter Member Advocate. The Member Advocate can assist you with the following: appointment scheduling, food disparities, transportation, breast pumps, health and safety, or any other resources that will support your happy and healthy pregnancy.

How to Enroll:

All pregnant and new moms are eligible for the Maternal Guidance Program. There are two ways to register for the program:

- **1.** Complete a Notification of Pregnancy (NOP) form and return it to Ambetter. You can complete the NOP via one of two ways:
 - a. Log in to your member portal to inform us of your pregnancy at: <u>Member.AmbetterHealth.com</u>, or
 - b. Contact the Member Services team at 1-877-617-0390 (TTY: 1-877-617-0392).
- **2.** Once Ambetter has been notified of your pregnancy, an Ambetter Member Advocate will reach out to you and provide you with the opportunity to enroll in the Maternal Guidance Program.
