

# CHILD AND ADOLESCENT WELL-CARE VISITS (WCV)

## PROVIDER TIP SHEET



### What is Being Measured?

This measure assesses the percentage of members 3-21 years of age, as of December 31, who had at least one comprehensive well-care visit with a PCP or an OB/GYN practitioner during the measurement year.



### Why is This Measure Important?

Assessing physical, emotional, and social development is important at every stage of life. Well-care visits provide an opportunity for providers to evaluate members' health and development and are a critical opportunity for screening and counseling.



### Eligible Population

All members between the ages of 3 and 21 years old.



### Medical Record Documentation

Acceptable medical record documentation includes:

- A well-care visit with the PCP or OB/GYN in the measurement year.
- A comprehensive well-care visit may be completed during a visit for a chronic or acute condition.
- Synchronous telehealth visit.

Documentation must include evidence of a health, physical developmental, mental developmental history, and a complete physical exam.
